

CCP Discipline Policy

Centerville Church Preschool subscribes to a philosophy of child development based on mutual respect and growth toward potential. We view children as active, curious and social. When children behave in inappropriate ways, the staff will make every effort to help the child understand how to behave in more appropriate and effective ways. Teachers will use a variety of approaches to meet the needs of children including:

- Gentle guidance
- Proximity
- Direct teaching and instruction
- Reflective listening
- Problem solving
- Redirection
- Shadowing

NO CORPORA PUNISHMENT SHALL BE USED AT ANY TIME BY TEACHERS, PARENTS, OR VOLUNTEERS WHILE AT SCHOOL.

In certain circumstances children will be given an age-appropriate time-out when all other methods are unsuccessful. Children with extreme behavior challenges will be put on a Behavior Plan at a Parent-Teacher Conference.

Children will not be yelled at or humiliated in any way. At no time shall a child's personal rights be violated by teachers or parents/guardians.
